

or elsewhere in the Village of Concord, and all other places where spirituous or intoxicating liquors are sold either at wholesale or at retail in said Village, shall be closed on each week day night from and after the hour of nine o'clock until six o'clock of the morning of the succeeding day. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this section shall, on conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not less than twenty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, besides costs of prosecution, or imprisonment in the Village prison or county jail not exceeding ninety days, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after its passage.

An Ordinance To Prevent And Punish Disorderly Conduct.

The Village of Concord ordains as follows:

Section 1. Any person who may hereafter be found lurking, lying in wait or concealed in any house, or other building, or in any yard, or upon the premises of any person, within the limits of the Village of Concord, with intent to do any mischief, or to pilfer, or to commit any crime or misdemeanor whatsoever, shall, for every such offense, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Section 2. All persons who within the limits of said Village shall make, aid or assist in making any disturbance or riot, or who shall be guilty of any indecent, immoral, or insulting conduct, language or behavior in the streets or elsewhere in said Village; and all persons who shall congregate in bodies or crowds in said Village for unlawful purposes, or to the annoyance or disturbance of citizens or travelers; and all persons who within the limits of said Village engage in any quarrel, brawl, fight or other disturbance of the peace, shall, for each offense, on conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after its passage.

*Revised* BY-LAW No. XI.

An Ordinance To Prevent And Punish Sabbath Desecration.

The Village of Concord ordains as follows:

Section 1. No person shall keep open his shop, store, warehouse or workhouse, in the Village of Concord, or shall do any manner of labor, business or work therein, or be present at any dancing, or at any diversion, show, or entertainment in said Village, or take part in any sport, game, or play therein on the first day of the week. The foregoing shall not apply to such works of necessity and charity or other acts excepted by act of the legislature of the State of Michigan from the operation of the statutes enacted for the observance of the first day of the week, and the prevention and punishment of immorality. Every person offending against the provisions of this section shall, upon the conviction thereof, be punished by fine not exceeding ten dollars for each offense.
