

ORDINANCE 111-A

(October 2, 1956)

ORDINANCE TO WATER DEPARTMENT

On water service provided to customer outside the Village limits excepting those customers who were part of the original installation of the water system in 1951, the rates shall be one quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$) higher than the rate charged in the Village and if mains or services are extended outside the Village the adjoining property owners shall pay the entire cost of such extension of mains and service. All pipe from main shall be (1") one inch copper pipe from Mains to the construction inside the building. A deposit of (\$10.00) ten dollars shall be maintained in advance for each service to guarantee payment of monthly service charge.

The Village Council shall reserve the right to allow or deny such extension of main or service as they shall see fit.
