

## AMENDMENT TO WATER ORDINANCE 111 E.

We have resolved that the Village of Concord, in the County of Jackson and State of Michigan hereby do delete from Section 3 of the Water Ordinance, the following two paragraphs:

"For the purpose of lessing the administrative costs of billings, the consumers or users shall hereafter be divided into three approximately equal groups with each group to have a different billing date, so that each group shall be sent a billing once every three (3) months.

a. Commencing in the month of April, 1962, the first consumer/user group shall be billed; commencing in the month of May, 1962, the second consumer/user group shall be billed, and commencing in the month of June, 1962, the third consumer/user group shall be billed, and thereafter such billing shall continue on the quarterly billing for each group of consumer/users."

And in its place, there shall be added this amended paragraph:

"Commencing on the first day of January, 1972, the consumers of water who are obtaining their water from the Village of Concord, shall be billed monthly and shall be continued to be billed monthly and such billing shall be made along with whatever sewage billing they had for the said month, if the same is applicable to said consumers.

We have resolved that the Village of Concord, in the County of Jackson and State of Michigan shall amend from the Water Ordinance, Section 2, the following.

The first sentence of said paragraph of Section 2 shall be deleted, and in its place, there shall be added this amended sentence to read as follows: "Billing for water use shall hereafter be made once each month and water bills shall be sent to consumers monthly and shall become due and payable fifteen (15) days after date of such bill."
