

ORDINANCE # 118

JUNK YARD

THE VILLAGE OF CONCORD ORDAINS:

It is hereby resolved by the Village Council of Concord, Michigan from the first day of November A.D. 1956, all junk yards must be licensed to operate in order to protect the public health and welfare: said licenses to be obtained by application to the Village Council, who for just cause may refuse to grant said license.

An annual fee for inspection and regulation in the amount of \$ 15.00 is to be charged for said license.

All junk yards must be inside the Village of Concord and none is to be within 200 feet of any street or building unless said junk yard is enclosed with a tight board fence at least six feet high, Also no junk cars, trucks or other vehicles shall be burned within the Village of Concord.

Any violation of the Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or not to exceed 90 days in jail, or both in the descretion of the court.
