ORDINANCE # 124

AN ORDINANCE ON UNNECESSARY MOTOR VEHICLE NOISE.

THE VILLAGE OF CONCORD ORDAINS:

All motor vehicles shall be operated without unnecessary noise and any person who so turns, starts, or moves a motor vehicle or so applies the brakes or the power on any motor vehicle, or in any other manner operates such motor vehicle, so as to cause the tires to squeal or make any noise not usually connected with the operation of such motor vehicle, except in the case of emergencies, shall be guilty of a prima facie violation of this ordinance.

Upon conviction for any violation of this ordinance, the penalty shall be a maximum of ninety (90) days in the County Jail and/or a \$100.00 fine, or both, at the discretion of the court.

This ordinance shall be published in full in the Concord News, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Concord qualified under State law to publish legal notices within two weeks of its adoption.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 48

November 9, 1965

Amend Ordinance # 48 to change parking hours to read: No parking on any street in the Village limits between the hours of 2 A.M. and 6 A.M. for the purpose of removing snow and cleaning the streets. (The time was changed so as not to conflict with the business at the restaurant on Main Street.)

Enact an addition to Ordinance # 48 to limit parking to two hours in the business district. The business district to be defined as South to Center St., East to Union Street, West to Maple Street and North to M-60.

These amendments to be effective immediately.

Any part of these amendments which conflicts with any part of original ordinance shall not void any other parts of the original ordinance.
