

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 144

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 144 (the "Ordinance") of the Village of Concord, Jackson County, Michigan, commonly known as the "Concord C.A.T.V. Ordinance" established a Community Antenna Television System (also known as "Cable-TV" in the Village of Concord, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance grants a Franchise to Thomas J. and Carola J. Ridley (the "Ridleys"), d/b/a/ Concord Cablevision Company, and

WHEREAS, the Ridley's have assigned all their rights, title and interests under the above Ordinance and Franchise to a Michigan corporation also known as Concord Cablevision Company,

THEREFORE, amend preamble to read: AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF CONCORD, COUNTY OF JACKSON, STATE OF MICHIGAN, AND TO GRANT A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO CONCORD CABLEVISION COMPANY (A MICHIGAN CORPORATION) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION THEREOF.

Repeal definition of Company to read: "COMPANY" SHALL MEAN THOMAS R. AND CAROLA J. RIDLEY, d/b/a/ CONCORD CABLEVISION COMPANY (A MICHIGAN CORPORATION), OR ANYONE WHO SUCCEEDS THIS COMPANY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED HEREIN.
