

ORDINANCE #150

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ACT FOR MICHIGAN CITIES, TOWNSHIPS AND VILLAGES.

THE VILLAGE OF CONCORD ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. CODE ADOPTED

The Motor Carrier Safety Act for Cities, Townships and Villages promulgated by the Director of State Police and published with the Secretary of State, June 22, 1984, in accordance with Public Act 181 of 1963, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as in this ordinance modified.

SECTION 2. REFERENCES IN CODE

References in the Motor Carrier Safety Act for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the VILLAGE OF CONCORD

SECTION 3. NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED

The VILLAGE CLERK shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall at the same time publish a supplementary notice setting forth the purpose of the said Motor Carrier Safety Act and of the fact that a complete copy of the Act is available at the office of the Clerk for inspection by public at all times.

SECTION 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED

All other ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Motor Carrier Safety Act are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE

The Motor Carrier Safety Act will be in effect in this governmental unit 20 days after the passage of this adopting ordinance.

SECTION 6. PURPOSE OF ACT

The purpose of such Act is to regulate the operation of motor trucks, tractors and trailers; to provide the number of persons necessary to the operation of such motor trucks and tractors; to limit the hours of service of persons engaged in operating such vehicles; to require the keeping of records of such operations; to provide for the assessment of fees; to provide penalties for the violation of this act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts, within the VILLAGE of CONCORD.



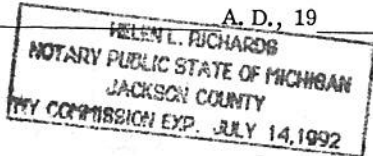
