

ORDINANCE NO. 157

ORDINANCE FOR ACQUIRING PROPERTY

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the acquiring of property required for the use of the Village; and to provide for the sale of property owned by the Village that is no longer needed. As provided in 1895 PA 3 (MCL 65.5 (2); MSA 5.1268).


THE VILLAGE OF CONCORD ORDAINS:


The village may acquire, purchase, and erect public buildings required for the use of the Village, and may purchase, appropriate, and own real estate necessary for public grounds, parks, markets, public buildings, and other purposes necessary or convenient for the public good, and for the exercise of the powers conferred in 1895 PA 3 (MCL 65.5 (2); MSA 5.1268).

Such buildings and grounds, or any part thereof, may be sold at a public or private sale, or may be leased. However, a public park shall not be sold without the consent of a majority of the electors of the Village voting on the question at an election.

Real estate or an interest shall not be purchased, leased, sold, or disposed of except by a majority vote of the members of council.
