

## BY-LAWS.

## By-Law No. I.

*Revised*  
An Ordinance relative to Lewd and Lascivious Behavior In  
the Streets Or Other Public Places.

The Village of Concord ordains:

Section 1. That it shall not be lawful for any person to exhibit any lewd or lascivious behavior or conduct in any street or public place at any time day or night; or bathe in the river, pond or race in the Village of Concord between the hours of five o'clock in the morning and ten o'clock in the evening unless clothed. Any person shall upon conviction before a competent court, of the violation of any of the provisions of this section, be punished by a fine not to exceed fifty dollars besides costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed three months, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

By-Law No. II.An Ordinance Relative to Auctioneers.

The Village of Concord ordains:

Section 1. That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to engage in, follow, or practice the business or occupation of auctioneer, or sell any goods or personal property at auction or public sale within the corporate limits of the Village of Concord without first having procured a license therefor, as hereinafter provided; and this ordinance shall apply to, and include all persons who cry their wares, whether to the lowest or highest bidder or at a fixed price.

Section 2. The President and Village Clerk are hereby authorized to license any person or firm to engage in or follow the business of auctioneer in said Village of Concord, on paying to the Treasurer of said Village the sum of twenty-five dollars for carrying on such business for the period of twelve months from and including the date of said license, and the sum of two dollars per day for any shorter period.

Section 3. The person or firm applying for such license shall first pay to the Treasurer of said Village the sum herein before specified and take his receipt therefor, and on presentation thereof to the Clerk of the Village, such license shall be made out and after the same shall have been signed by the President of the Village, be delivered to such person.

Section 4. This ordinance shall not apply to any officer or person making sale of property by virtue of any execution or other process or order of court or public law, or to any person making sale of personal property upon chattel mortgage foreclosure.

Section 5. Any person engaging in such business, or who follows or practices the business of auctioneer within the corporate limits of said Village of Concord or who attempts so to do, or who sells or attempts to sell at public sale or auction, within such corporate limits contrary to the provisions of this ordinance, shall be punished, upon conviction thereof, by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
