ORDINANCE # 31

An ordinance regulating the sale and use of fire-works and explosives, and devices for firing the same in the Village of Concord, Michigan.

Section 1. No person shall fire or set off within the Corporate limits of the Village of Concord any toy cannon or pistol, dynamite fire crackers, cannon fire crackers, dynamite torpedos, or any other fire works containing dynamite, giant powder or any other higher explosive than ordinary gunpowder.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation shall sell or offer for sale within the corporate limits of the Village of Concord, any dynamite fire crackers, cannon fire-crackers, dynamite torpedos, or any other fire works containing dynamite, giant powder, or any other higher explosive than ordinary gunpowder, or any toy cannon, toy pistol or other device intended for firing blank cartridges, or any cartridges, or caps intended for use in such pistols, cannons or other devices.

Section 3. No person shall fire or set off within the corporate limits of the Village of Concord, any fireworks or explosives of any kind on any other day than the Fourth day of July, without first obtaining permission from the Common Council.

Section 4. Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, before any competent court having jurisdiction shall be subject to a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars and costs of prosecution, or not more than thirty days in the county jail, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Section 5. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to arrest all persons whom he shall see engaging in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance and to make complaint before any justice having jurisdiction thereof, of all persons guilty of violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance and to take all proper and necessary steps and measures for the enforcement of same.
