

An ordinance to repeal an ordinance providing for saloons and the regulation of same in the Village of Concord, passed April 30th, 1915.

The Village of Concord ordains as follows:

That an ordinance known as By-Law number thirty-six (36) of the Village of Concord, passed April 30th, 1915, entitled, an ordinance to repeal an ordinance prohibiting saloons in the Village of Concord, passed April 26, 1911, be and the same is hereby repealed. Further that By-Law number thirty-five (35) of the Village of Concord passed April 26, 1911, entitled an ordinance prohibiting saloons in the Village of Concord, Michigan, be again enacted as a By-Law and ordinance.
