An ordinance to comform with Public Act No. 51, 1917, relative to compensation of Village President and Trustees.

The Village of Concord, Michigan, ordains as follows:

Section 1. The President and Trustees of said Village of Concord, State of Michigan, shall receive the sum of one dollar for each meeting of the Village Council by them respectively attended during their term of office, and not to exceed the sum of twenty-five (25) dollars in any one year; such payment to be made out of the general fund of the village treasury. Said officers shall receive no other compensation for services for and on behalf of said village during their term of office, provided that in no case shall such president or any trustee receive compensation for any meeting not actually attended.

All other officers except, where provision is made herein, or by law regulating fees for services, shall receive such

compensation as the Council shall prescribe.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect (20) twenty days after its passage.

ORDINANCE # 41

An ordinance prohibiting the driving of tractors or traction engine, gas, gasoline, steam or electric, or any machine with lugs on the wheels; also to prohibit the building of fires on any pavement or paved street in the Village of Concord.

The Village of Concord ordains as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive any tractor or traction engine either steam, gasoline, gas or electric, or any machine with lugs on the wheels, on any pavement or paved street in the Village of Concord and it shall also be unlawful to build any fires on said paved streets. Anyone violating this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (100.00) and shall also pay damage done to said pavement or shall be liable to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not to exceed ninety days or both in the discretion of the court, for each and every violation.
