ORDINANCE # 45

A curfew Ordinance within the limits of said Village.

The Village of Concord ordains:

Section 1. All children under the age of fourteen (14) are to be off the streets of the Village, unless accompanied by their parents or guardian, at ten (10) o'clock P.M. on Monday through Friday nights of each week and at eleven (11) o'clock P.M. on Saturday and Sunday nights.

Section 2. While the Concord Soya Corporation is in operation the whistle will be sounded at the above mentioned time and in the event that the Soya Corporation is not in operation, the village fire siren will be used for such purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on June 15, 1947.

Section 4. Violations of provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than ten (10) dollars, plus costs, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not more than ten (10) days, or both, at the discretion of the court, said fine or imprisonment to be enforced upon the parents or guardians of those found guilty in violation of this ordinance.

Approved by the Common Council of the Village of Concord, Jackson County, Michigan, on the second day of June, 1947.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 45 CURFEW ORDINANCE

An amendment to the curfew ordinance No. 45 on motion of Waldby and supported by Smith that the curfew be changed to 9:30 P.M. each night with the exception of Friday and Saturday nights at which time it will be sounded at 10:30 P.M. The age limit be extended to sixteen (16) inclusive, Amendment to be in force beginning with Saturday, December 6, 1947. Carried.
