

AMENDMENT TO SECTION ONE (1) IN ITS ENTIRETY OF BY-LAW VIII

TO READ THUSLY:

"Sidewalks constructed, repaired or replaced for the Village of Concord shall be built of cement according to the following general specifications:

Concrete shall have a compressive strength of not less than 3000 lbs. per square inch after 28 days. The width shall be not less than four (4) feet except where existing walks are to be repaired or replaced in which event the width shall be the same as the existing walk. The thickness shall be four (4) inches except in driveways where it shall be six (6) inches. The slabs shall be marked with a radius divider tool to form square blocks. Construction joints and expansion joints shall be provided. Walks shall be sloped from the property line down towards the street.

The Village Engineer or any one appointed by the Village Council shall present details of aforesaid general specifications to any party or parties constructing, repairing or replacing any sidewalks for the Village so that they will be well informed of the exact requirements. Any party or parties constructing, repairing or replacing sidewalks for the Village must understand that if these detailed specifications are not conformed with, said party or parties will be held responsible, and liable for any defects in workmanship and/or material in the construction, repairs or replacements.
