RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, It is to the mutual advantage and benefit of all the people in the Village of Concord to promote housing, business and industrial development in this Village and to attract business and industry to create payrolls and improve the general economic condition of the Village of Concord;

AND, WHEREAS, Ellwood A. Voller, Behavery Voller, Roderick Smith and Ruth Smith are the owners of the land hereinafter described, which they are promoting for housing, business and industrial development and approve of annexation of said property to the Village of Concord and it is of great importance for any such housing, business and industrial development to have water lines and sewer extended to the site;

WHEREAS, said area is immediately adjacent to the present Village westerly boundary and lies south of Allman Road and is well adaptable to both present and future economic development of the effected area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Village Council of the Village of Concord in a regular meeting as follows:

1. That the Village Council of Concord, Jackson County, Michigan, does hereby petition the Board of Supervisors of the County of Jackson to detach from the Township of Concord and annex to the Village of Concord the following described land:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 33, T35, R3W, Concord Township, Jackson County, Michigan, at the intersection of the North line of Allman Rd. and the centerline of Homer Road; thence West along the North line of Allman Road and the present Village limits 1320 ft. more or less to the East $\frac{1}{8}$ line of said section 33; thence South along the East $\frac{1}{8}$ line of section 33, 1220 ft. more or less to the centerline of Homer Road; thence N $49^{\circ} 20''$ E. along the centerline of Homer Road 500 ft. more or less; thence Southeasterly perpendicular to the centerline of Homer Road 335 ft. more or less to a point 740 ft. West of the East Line of Section 33, T 35, R3W; thence South parallel with the East line of Section 33, 1580 ft. more or less to the East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ line of Section 33, at a point 740 ft. West of the East $\frac{1}{4}$ post of Section 33; thence East along the East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ line 740 ft.; to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ post of Section 33 thence North along the East line of Section 33 to a point 1150 ft. South of the North-East corner of Section 33; thence West 165.00 ft.; thence Northwesterly 858 ft. to the centerline of Homer Road; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of Homer Road; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of Homer Road 350 ft. more or less to the point of beginning.

Contains 45.5 acres.

That the President and the Clerk of the Village of Concord are hereby authorized to sign a petition directed to the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County and to attach a copy of this resolution to the petition, said petition requesting that the Board of Supervisors hold a hearing and take action on the petition as prayed for in the petition.
