Section 2. Effective Date

Section 3. Severability

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Publication

This Ordinance shall be published in full in The Salesman, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Concord, qualified under State law to publish legal notices, within one week of its adoption.
