The owners of the aggressive dog had been warned prior to this for the dogs getting loose, and they were cited for having the dangerous animal.



4/7 - I assisted another county unit in Hanover on a domestic assault situation involving a claw hammer.



4/11 - I assisted CPS with a child custody case at the elementary school.



4/14 - Units dealt with a highly intoxicated female walking in and out of traffic on S. Main St. She was ultimately transported to the hospital for medical attention.



4/17 - Units responded to the Dollar General for a shoplifting complaint involving several subjects.



4/20 - Units were dispatched to Albion Rd. near Schultz Rd. for a traffic crash in which rescue was on-scene. The driver was ultimately arrested for drunk driving and taken to jail.



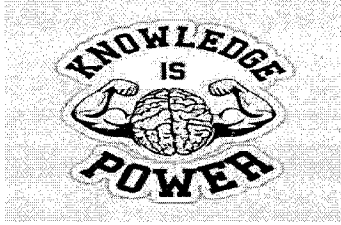
4/25 - A report came in of subjects hurling Briar's Ice Cream chunks at a home on Keeler Rd. There's no word on the flavor involved.
