

Village of Concord Council Minutes

The Village Council of Concord met on April 14, 2020 at 7:00 pm virtually on Zoom:

Council Members Present: Jeremiah Bush, Jeff Jackson, T. Casey, A. Meeks, Mike Lovitt, T. Norris and Kyle George.

Public Present: Ken Wyatt, Linda Lovitt, Teresa Karr-Jackson, DPW Director J. Blossom, and Deputy L. Jacobson.

J Bush welcomed everyone to the Concord Village Council Meeting and stated it was the Council's intention to quickly get through this meeting due to time constraints and potential tech issues. An overview of the agenda was presented as follows, passing of the language of the previous March 10, 2020 meeting minutes; Payment of Village Bills in the amount of \$68,307.03; Payment of USDA RD Water Project Payment Approval \$268,110.74; and A five year renewal of our police services contract with Jackson County Sheriff's Department at roughly \$86,000 a year to split two ways with Concord Township.

Motioned by J. Bush, seconded by M. Lovitt, to accept the minutes from the 3/10/2020 meeting. Motion approved by all.

Public Comment:

K. Wyatt stated he was happy to see everyone and applauded the Village Council for their willingness to embrace technology and attempting to complete a Council Meeting virtually.

K. Wyatt also asked if there had been any updates on when the Village's USDA Water Project would resume. J. Blossom said he has been in regular contact with Concord Excavating and they wouldn't be back to work until the Stay at Home Order is lifted.

L. Lovitt spoke about her concern of automobiles and semi-trucks speeding down Hanover St. in front of her house. J. Bush said he was aware of her complaints and others including recently down the street where a semi hit a utility pole. J. Bush stated he drove this stretch of street regularly and often observed Dep. Jacobson

set up in several places clocking for speeders. Dep. Jacobson spoke of his reluctance to write tickets for people driving slightly over the speed limit and stated he often patrols the Hanover Street area. Dep. Jacobson said he would up his patrols in the area and ticket any driver doing more than ten miles over the speed limit.


Motioned by J. Bush, seconded by K. George, to Pay Village Bills in the amount of \$68,307.03. Motion approved by all.


