The Village Council of Concord met on May 9, 2023 at 7:00 pm in the Village Commons Meeting Room.

Council Members Present: Jeremiah Bush, J. Jackson, T. Norris, T. Thurman, A. Meeks, M. Lovitt and K. George.

Council Members Absent: None.

Public Present: K. Wyatt, D. Saenz, Deputy L. Jacobson, DPW Director J. Blossom and Village Clerk J. Lefere.

Motioned by A. Meeks, seconded by K. George to accept the minutes from the 4/11/2023 meeting. Motion approved by all.

Public Comments:

- D. Saenz stated that the Community Clean-up date has changed. It will be a 2-part. May 20th will be the tire recycling day for Concord Village, Concord Township, Hanover and Pulaski. The Concord Township and Village clean-up day will be on August 5th from 8am to 11am. \$10.00 per load. He also commented that he is still working on getting the 55 MPH sign moved on Sears Rd.
- K. Wyatt asked for an update on the trail extension. J. Bush stated that he has not heard anything. He also asked for an update on the Paddock boat launch. J. Bush stated that part of the land belongs to a resident and the village is waiting on the survey to do a land swap.
- J. Bush informed the council that a resident that lives on the edge of the village inquired if the village would allow him to have two pigs temporarily for his grandkids to do 4H. The council decided not to allow this as they have turned down other residents in the past.
- J. Bush mentioned resident Jamie Doty had planned to attend the meeting to discuss his brush pile. He did not attend the meeting.

The Payment of Bills in the amount of \$39,800.11 was presented. Motioned by A. Meeks, seconded by J. Jackson, to approve the payment of bills in the amount of \$39,800.11. Motion approved by all.

- J. Bush presented the resolution for category B grant funding proposal for Allman Rd. Motioned by J. Bush, seconded by M. Lovitt. All were in favor. Motion approved.
- L. Jacobson discussed his April 2023 Police Blotter. To view a copy of L. Jacobson's Concord Area Police Blotter, go to the Village website at www.villageofconcord.com look on the home page quick links. A copy may also be picked up in the Village Office.
- J. Blossom informed the council that the trash cans on Main St. need to be replaced. Motioned by A. Meeks, seconded by T. Norris to purchase 4 new trash cans for Main St. All were in favor. Motion approved. He also discussed the cost of speed limit signs. The cost for 2 signs is \$6,182.96. they can be moved around the village. He is checking on the cost of the batteries and will be discussed at a future meeting. J. Blossom stated that the M-60 water project is complete.

Council Comments:

J. Jackson commented on how nice the parking lot looks at the DPW garage.
