## CALLS OF NOTE



March 1: A township resident was working with her bank after she discovered her identity had been stolen and checks were being written in her name in Louisiana, Florida, and Texas. The suspects were actually pulled over on a traffic stop in Louisiana and the police discovered hundreds of falsified documents. This particular group is from New York and illegally purchased identities on the dark web before flying down south and cashing false checks. The FBI is now handling and at least suspects are in custody.



March 7: I assisted the Spring Arbor Township Police Department on a B&E case involving an obtained search warrant and recovery of stolen property.



March 12: A subject on Hanover St. ran through the lights of a stopped school bus. He was identified and cited.



March 13: I assisted Concord High School reference a suspicious situation.



March 16: I was dispatched to an address on Hanover St. for a domestic situation in which each party was shouting about how badly they wanted the other to die. Fortunately, no one actually died.



March 20: I handled an MDOP complaint on N. Concord Rd. in which an adult son damaged his mother's vehicle because he was having issues with his girlfriend.



March 22: During the blizzard, a vehicle rolled over on S. Parma Rd in a ditch, but fortunately no one was injured.



March 25: Units responded to a residence on Behling Rd. involving an upset grandmother who lost her cell phone.
