CALLS OF NOTE



July 3: I assisted the Parma and Sandstone units on W. Michigan Ave. on an assault case involving an axe. A male subject was arrested during the investigation.



July 5: I assisted rescue units with a subject suffering some type of medical emergency at the Cadet Tavern. He was transported via ambulance to the hospital for medical attention.



July 8: The ongoing saga on Third St. in the Village continues, with the mother of one of the parties being charged with multiple court-order violations for going onto the property despite a judge telling her not to.



July 9: After a large storm, a massive tree fell on a Consumers Energy bucket truck on French Rd. Luckily, the worker had just exited the bucket and escaped injury.



July 10: A deer tried to leap the iron fence on Sears Rd but misjudged his jump and impaled himself on it. It had to be put down.



July 12: Multiple state, county and emergency units responded to a crash at M-60 & Main St. in the Village. A woman in a van, trying to turn westbound onto M-60, pulled right out in front of an eastbound tractor trailer. Despite the truck driver's best

efforts, there was no way to avoid the collision. The woman in the van was pronounced deceased at the scene.



July 14: Units responded to a B&E on Parsons Rd in which a single kayak was taken.



July 15: I responded to a burglary on Allman Rd, but this one was domestic related.



July 19: Units responded to an potential sexual conduct case on Bath Mills Rd.



July 20: Schlegel Sand & Gravel had their Mann Rd. complex hit again. Copper wires were cut away and stolen. They still have not taken steps to put a security system in place.



July 23: I responded to the area in front of the PS Food Mart on M-60 for a car v. work van crash.
