CALLS OF NOTE



September 6: I handled a call in which some parents in Concord boarded a school bus to confront a 10 year-old boy about a school incident involving their son. And THEIR son was the aggressor in the incident.



September 6: I assisted with traffic control while a large funeral procession rolled through town.



September 8: I met with the parents of some young people rolling through town on their mini-motorcycles (pocket bikes) doing wheelies. The parents agreed to put a stop to this and - at least as of October 1 - it's stopped being an issue.



September 10: I participated in a large scale, active shooter training event at the Optimist Ice Arena in Jackson.



September 13: Myself and multiple units - including the State Police - responded to a mental health call in the village on Michigan St. The subject ultimately went to a facility for treatment.



September 14: I responded to a factory at the county line to arrest a subject on a felony warrant for domestic assault. Upon seeing myself and the state police, the subject fled the factory on foot, but was eventually cornered and taken into custody. The young and extremely athletic state trooper did all of the running while I loped along behind her and called everything out over the radio.



September 16: I was dispatched to the Falling Waters Trail near Parsons Rd. for a juvenile laying in the grass. It was ultimately determined that he was a runaway from a facility in the Detroit area and listed as 'endangered/missing.' He was taken to the hospital for dehydration and then turned back over to protective services.



September 17: Over a 24-hour period, there were several 911 calls reference juvenile complaints at an address on Monroe St. in the village.



September 19: In a SHOCKING display of animal stupidity, a large swan flew into a transformer near Main St. & M-60, briefly knocking out power to the area. Although not officially confirmed, it was indeed the bird's swan song. (See what I did there? Two in one notice.)



September 22: I was dispatched to an address on Albion Rd. for a suspicious person knocking on doors. It was later discovered he was legit and merely campaigning for Donald Trump.



I made a traffic stop on a vehicle in the village for doing 41 in a 25 zone. The subject had just received his driver's license so, in lieu of a citation, we called his mother together to report his behavior. When he finished the call, he stated 'next time I'll take the ticket.'
