CALLS OF NOTE



12/4: I worked with high school staff reference a series of threats involving some young men. The threats stemmed from issues with a girl - shocker.



12/4: A rabid, blood-thirsty bat was loose in the Village Office - terrorizing the staff. Using my cat-like reflexes, I was able to trap the bat in a cardboard box and deposit it outside. The creature's whereabouts.... are unknown.



12/5: Two subjects on Warner Rd. had freshly-delivered packages stolen off their front porches. I have been able to identify the suspect (a Pulaski resident) and am working to get him charged with the crimes.



12/7: I handled a single-vehicle crash on Erie Rd. taken during icy conditions. While removing the vehicle from a ditch, the wrecker clunked into another vehicle, resulting in a second report.



12/10: Myself and several other deputies checked a large chunk of property in the township for a man with multiple sexual misconduct warrants. He was not located and is still out there - now possibly residing in a camper somewhere in Pulaski.



12/13: The Trailhead Coffee Shop reports that someone walked off with one of the seat cushions provided to their customers for sensitive bottoms. I have double checked my vehicle and I'm certain I've returned it.



12/19: A pair of Hillsdale County residents - with multiple drug warrants - were doing their laundry at the Concord Laundromat when they were approached by a deputy at 2:00 in the morning. They proceeded to drive off at a high rate of speed and a pursuit ensued. Eventually, the deputy terminated the pursuit due to road conditions and the vehicle surging into Calhoun County. Additional charges were authorized.



12/20: A subject from November - who passed a counterfeit \$100 bill at Concord's Dollar General - has been identified and charged with multiple counts of the crime.



12/21: I came on at 5:00am to catch a specific speeder on Hanover St, but was diverted to Homer Rd. instead for a single vehicle crash in which the highly intoxicated driver - shoeless and in shorts - was doing snow-angels in someone's front yard. He ultimately ran off into the park where he collapsed and began flopping around like a fish out of water. Ultimately, he was taken to the hospital for medical treatment and charged with the crime. During the process, he called me multiple names including 'Porky', 'Fat f-k' and 'Iron Lung.' Ironically, those are all names my ex-wife used to call me.
