CALLS OF NOTE



1/02 - Units responded to the area of Hanover St. & Main St. for a situation in which a businesses' former employee brandished a firearm during an argument. The subject was easily identified and felonious assault charges are pending.



1/04 - A woman driving near French Rd. & Albion Rd. flashed her high-beams at an oncoming vehicle due to the brightness of that vehicle's lights. This apparently enraged the driver of that oncoming vehicle – a Jeep Wrangler – and he proceeded to chase the woman around in a road-rage incident. That investigation continues.



1/06 - A local man was inside the Cadet Tavern enjoying a delicious hamburger, when his parked vehicle began rolling away – in reverse – down Main St. Apparently his dog – waiting inside his truck – tripped the transmission into neutral and off it went. No word yet on charges against the dog for possible vehicle theft.



1/09 - I assisted other county units on W. Mich. Ave. in Parma on the felony warrant arrest of a subject.



1/10 - I assisted other units down on Wheeler Rd where a fugitive, with multiple sexual misconduct warrants, was finally located and taken into custody.



1/16 – I assisted the Spring Arbor Police Department in arresting a subject who brandished a firearm during an argument with his mother.



1/17 – I was dispatched to an address on Elm Row Rd. involving the death of a newly born infant. Due to the severity and nature of the call, the Detective Bureau assumed control of the investigation and it remains ongoing.



1/17 - I responded to the intersection of N. Main St. & M-60 for a crash involving an SUV and a WOW van. No one was injured.



1/19 – Units responded to a minor traffic crash on Main St. @ Homer Rd. in the village and the at-fault driver was taken into custody for drunk driving.
