2/4/2026: An elderly man went in to the Lightning Quick gas station, claiming he couldn't find his wife. He eventually found her at the Dollar General after a brief search – although he didn't appear overly thrilled to reconnect with her.



2/8/2026: County units arrested two different Concord residents on misdemeanor warrants after the jail notified supervisors that open spots were available. (One of the warrants was for failure to show up for jury duty and the other was for an unpaid traffic ticket. BOTH of these issues can usually be handled and cleared up with a phone call! Don't ASSUME this stuff will just go away! IT WON'T!)



2/12/2026: I assisted the Parma unit on a welfare check involving a suicidal subject who berated us upon arrival, answered all pertinent questions and kicked us off his property. Apparently, he was fine.



2/25/2026: I arrested a subject w/ multiple domestic-related warrants. When he asked what the warrants were for, I told him. His response: 'Well, sounds like I deserve it.'
