CALLS OF NOTE



3/3/2026: Someone left a message on my village office answering machine: 'Please send help,' along with an address that doesn't exist. In such a situation, call 911! I never found out who called, where the help was needed or what might have happened.



3/7/2026: Myself and another deputy responded to M-60 near Wheeler Rd. for a young girl riding a bike down the highway. It was ultimately determined the 14 y/o girl was running away to meet 'a friend' from Minnesota. She was returned home and both CPS and her parents were notified.



3/9/2026: Units responded to a residence on Mann Rd. where an irate resident was upset someone drove through his yard on an ATV. It was ultimately determined the subject on the ATV was an elderly man suffering from early onset dementia – so care is needed there. None of this mattered to the Mann Rd. resident, who remained irate, no matter the outcome.



3/10/2026: I assisted multiple county units on a domestic situation on Pulaski Rd. in which a subject wrestled, was ultimately tazed and finally taken into custody on a bevy of charges.



3/11/2026: I took a little road trip... A rolling domestic situation in a U-Haul van was initiated on the south end of the township before the vehicle ultimately drove through Hanover, up through Summit and finally into the city before we all caught up with them. Turns out, they were struggling with the U-Haul, scrounging around on the vehicle's floors for a dropped Red Bull and listening to loud music. There was NO domestic – but it was a nice day for a drive.



3/18/2026: County & state units responded to Aldrich St. in the village for a physical domestic assault situation involving multiple subjects who were – shocking! – intoxicated. Probable cause for an arrest was in-hand, but the prime suspect fled the area in his pickup truck. Charges are coming.



3/29/2026: Units responded to an address on Keeler Rd. in the township for a death investigation.



3/31/2026: The mysterious black dirt biker doing wheelies on village streets – the latest culprit to do this – has been located as a Hanover St. resident and warned. ANY future incidents will result in significant fines and costs. However, there are a couple additional doofuses still on the loose.



Every spring/summer we have an issue with dirt-bike style motorcycles driving down village streets doing wheelies, etc. (See above) Many times, they're not even speeding, just slow-rolling on two wheels, which is a civil violation.
